Contents and target group

The Community Nursing expert training course for nursing teachers, managers and specialists consists of 8 modules. Timing and duration of the course and number of modules can be modified based on customer needs. Minimum duration of each module is two days.

Module 4: Preventing risks in older adulthood

- » Physical activity and fall prevention
- » Illness and injury prevention
- » Preventing nutrition problems
- » Abuse and neglect prevention

Module 5: Management of common conditions in community setting

- » Management of dementia
- » Anxiety and depression
- » Sleep disorders
- » Pressure ulcers

Module 6: End of life care at home

- » Communication about end of life culturally sensitive approach

- » Palliative care at home
- » Symptom management at home

Module 7: Developing community nursing
