
- Toxicology is an applied science which has inputs from many scientific disciplines e.g. molecular biology, chemistry, anatomy, physiology and epidemiology
- There is a great demand for experts in toxicology in our increasingly chemical world.
- The programme in general toxicology provides its students with the basic scientific knowledge and professional skills to carry out human chemical risk assessment

- Applicants should have Bachelor's or higher degree from a recognized University in an applicable field
- Suitable background studies are for example medicine, biology, biosciences, veterinary medicine, dentistry, environmental sciences, animal physiology, pharmacy, biochemistry
- There is no entrance exam
- Students will be accepted to the program based on their previous studies and motivation letter

- Next application period: 1. Nov. 2017 31. Jan. 2018
  - The admission is conditional if the degree is not completed by 13th January 2017
